TITLE: Recognition of Tucson Breakfast Lions Club and America's Best Contacts & Eyeglasses

BACKGROUND:
Amphitheater Public Schools is partnering with the Tucson Breakfast Lions Club Foundation to conduct free vision screening for all K-3 students in the district during the 2015-16 school year as the result of a \$20,000 grant awarded by the Community Foundation of Southern Arizona.

As part of the "Better Vision - Brighter Futures" project grant, children who show probable vision difficulties, and may have financial challenges, will be referred to America's Best Contacts & Eyeglasses for a free eye exam and two pairs of free glasses, as needed. Each child referred will also receive a free book during his or her appointment.

The Tucson Breakfast Lions Club and America's Best Contacts & Eyeglasses are valuable community
