Before October 1st	COMPLETED	Chief Appraiser shall calculate and deliver written notice of voting entitlement to each taxing unit entitled to vote on Appraisal District Director positions.
Before October 15 <sup>th</sup>		Each taxing unit entitled to vote may nominate by resolution adopted by its governing body one candidate for each positions to be filled on the Appraisal District Board of Directors. You may nominate up to 5 candidates.  Resolution must be submitted to the Chief Appraiser by the deadline.
Before October 30 <sup>th</sup>		Chief Appraiser shall prepare a ballot listing the candidates alphabetically whose names were timely submitted and deliver it to the presiding officer of the governing body of each taxing unit.
Before December 15 <sup>th</sup>		The governing body of each taxing unit entitled to vote shall select its candidate(s) and cast its votes <u>by resolution</u> and submit it to the Chief Appraiser by the deadline.
Before December 31 <sup>st</sup>		The Chief Appraiser shall count the votes, declare the five candidates and submit the results to the governing body of each taxing unit and to the candidates. The Chief Appraiser shall resolve a tie vote by any method of chance
