CARES Act Funding Update

The Minnesota Department of Education will administer three funding streams under the CARES Act. The three streams are:

- The Governor's Emergency Education Relief (GEER) fund, which can be used to meet technology and summer learning needs.
- Formula allocations to districts and charter schools eligible for Title I, Part A funds. These allocations come from 90% of the state's Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) funds, which can be used to meet a wide range of local needs.
- State-directed grants using 9.5% of the state's ESSER funds, which can be
 used for summer learning needs, mental health supports, and other local
 needs.

These funds can be used for expenses dating back to March 13, 2020 and will remain available for obligation through September 30, 2022.

Greenbush Middle River School District Allocations

Federal: ESSER (Elementary and Secondary Emergency Relief) fund - [A component of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act): \$41,954

State: Governor's Emergency Education Relief [GEER] also a component of the CARES Act: \$2,388

\$41,954 + \$2,388 = \$44,342
