### Provide history/background information on your proposal:

Lorna Byrne Teacher, David Gerten has been teaching his lifeskill students and 21st Century basic cooking skills to 30 students over the course of the last 8 months. The area that he preps the food to go home has been lacking equipment to be effecient. With the addition of new kitchen equipment (pots,pans, bakeware, emersion blender, and updating outdated kitchen essentials), Mr. Gerten would be able to support more LBMS students and families, in particular his lifeskill students.
