Food Service Building Report

The Food Service Program has been in full swing from the Holidays.

Winter reimbursements are completed at this time.

At this time, The Food Service Program has implemented a continental style breakfast for Browning High School and Buffalo Hide Academy. The continental style breakfast with more food options for the students will ensure BHS/BHA students are eating a healthy breakfast and food of their choice.

The Food Service Program will also be starting up the Supper program which will be providing dinner to students from the Napi school kitchen on February 26th or first week of March at the latest. The program will be under the Child & Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) At Risk After School Program. At this time, this program does have a vacant position for assistant cook.

The Food Service Program has submitted our annual survey/report for the Food Distribution Program (usda commodities). The amount that was allocated was \$83,442.15 for commodities. The amount for dry/non-perishable/frozen allocated will be \$34,600, And, for the DoD fresh program will be \$48,000 (salad bar)

The Food Service Program is providing a FFVP snack (fresh fruit/vegetable 2xweek) which is the snack program during the school day that begun at the end of October. And, we are providing an after-school snack for students in tutoring and the night school (BHS) program (mon.-thurs.)

Food service is short on help of assistant cooks at Browning High School, Bullshoe Elementary, and Browning Elementary (3 positions). We are trying to get subs to help assist until positions are filled.

The Ware house has been working very hard daily to carry out their daily operations including the assistance they provide for the school kitchens, food deliveries, and mail. The warehouse clerk position that was previously vacant has been filled.

The copy center has a machine down which is called the RISO (2005-2024). This machine prints envelopes and capable of copying duplicates. We are waiting for some quotes from the sales manager at this time.

We are always happy to be a service for our students at Browning Public Schools.
