

A.C. Jones Academic UIL Results

Thirty medals were awarded to A. C. Jones Academic UIL Teams on Saturday, April 3, 2005 at the Conference 4A District 30 Spring Meet in Pleasanton, Texas.

The UIL science team consisting of 10th grader Lauron Fischer, 12th grader Paul Ingram, 10th grader Oscar Garza, 9th Grader Pablo Hidalgo and 11th grader Jeff Cortez; won 1st place for the third year in a row. Individual honors went to Fischer, 2nd; Ingram, 3rd and Garza, 6th. The team was coached by Ms. Ann Gartner.

The UIL Math team consisting of Fischer, Garza, Ingram and 12th grader Rebecca Geleide placed 1st in district. Individual medals went to Fischer, 1st; Garza, 2nd; Ingram, 4th and Geleide, 6th. The team was coached by Mr. Roy Hanus.

The UIL Number Sense team consisting of Fischer, Geleide, Cortez, and 10th grader Katherine Stricklin placed 2nd at district. Fischer placed 1st overall. The team was coached by Mr. Roy Ramirez.

The UIL Calculator Applications team consisting of Ingram, Geleide, Stricklin, and Cortez placed 2nd place. Ingram took a 5th place medal. This team was coached by Hanus.

Individual awards went to junior Trey Blanton who won 6th place in poetry, senior Christina Causey who won 2nd place in Ready Writing and 1st place in Literary Criticism. These students were coached by Mrs. Gina Latcham and Mr. Michael Westerhouse. Sticklin placed 6th in spelling and is coached by Miss Louanne Lebourveau. Crystal Rivas also competed in computer applications and was coached by Mrs. Anita DeLuna.

Students on 1st place teams or who placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd will advance to Region, which will be held Saturday, April 23, 2005 at University of Texas at San Antonio.
