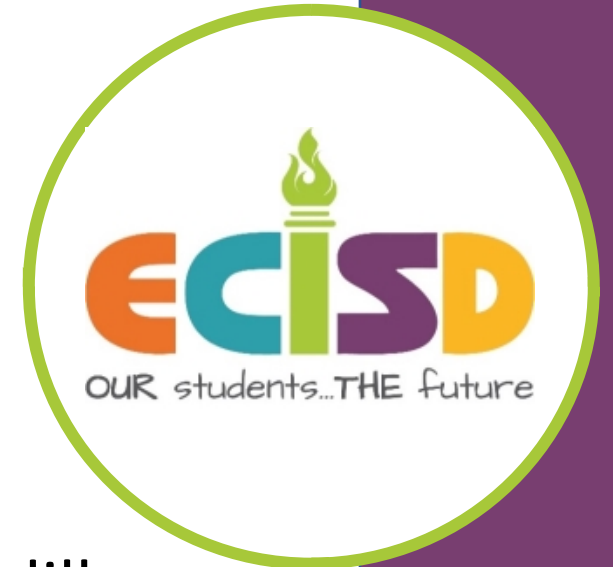

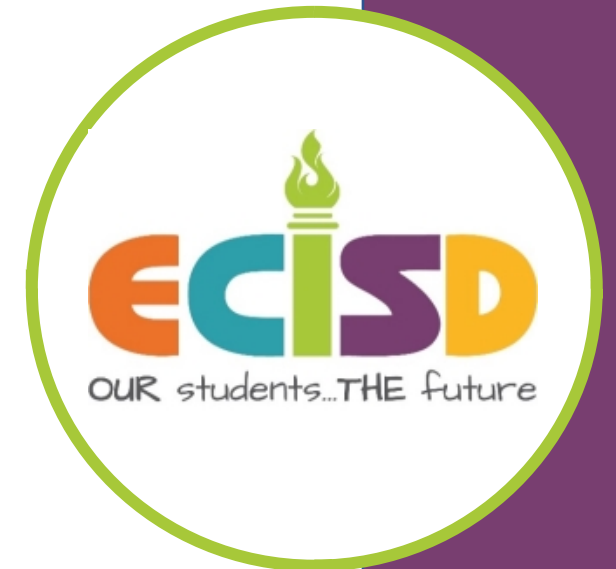

Why?

- Increase completion rates

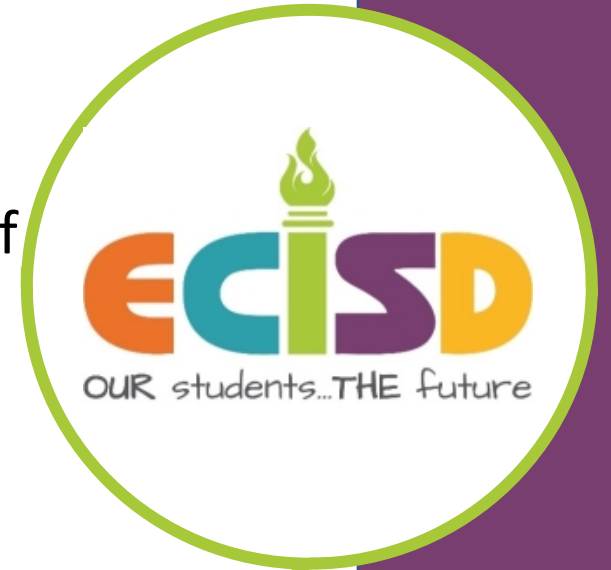

- Give principals an option to support students who are at risk of not graduating.
- Receive ADA funding for students who are currently receiving these type of services through the Community Outreach Center.

Objectives

- The program has two main objectives.
 - Allow a student who has dropped out of school or is in danger of dropping out of school an option other than the regular classroom setting or school day.
 - Enable a student the opportunity to recover credits lost due to lack of attendance.



Approval Process & Timeline

- Public hearing held and accepted on behalf of the School Board
- Application will be submitted to Texas Education Agency (TEA)
- Minimum of 30 days for review
- Must receive approval before initiating the program.
- Applications are approved for a period of one school year.
- Must apply annually
