## **BB 9300 GOVERNANCE**

Note: <u>A.S. 14.08.021</u> gives regional school boards jurisdiction over schools within regional educational attendance areas, military reservation schools and Bureau of Indian Affairs schools, subject to the laws and regulations that apply to all school districts. <u>A.S. 14.12.020</u> places the management and control of schools under the authority of school boards.

The formulation and adoption of written Board Policies shall constitute the basic method by which the School Board governs the District. This right shall be retained solely by the Board. The study and evaluation of reports concerning the execution of its policies shall constitute the basic method by which the Board exercises its accountability for the governance of the schools.

The Board has the power of establishing its own procedures within the parameters of law. All actions of the Board shall be taken only in official Board meetings according to these bylaws and the statutes of the state.
