

### OPTIONAL FLEXIBLE SCHOOL DAY PROGRAM (OFSDP)

2019-2020

• The Optional Flexible School Day Program (OFSDP) provides flexible hours and days of attendance for students that have or are in danger of dropping out of school

### Targets students

- Who are unable to attend in a traditional school setting
- Offers at-risk students who are in danger of being denied credit for classes due to attendance or have failed classes

- OFSDP offers students a fixed or flexible schedule to include:
  - Weekend or Night Classes
  - Extended Day Classes
  - Flexible Schedules
  - Credit Recovery Classes
- Current Campuses Judson and Wagner HS and JLA
  - Veterans Memorial HS has the option but student needs are currently being met at VMHS and/or JLA
  - Judson Early College Academy will be added for additional flexibility for students

#### o Staffing Needs:

- Personnel are compensated through supplemental pay by State Compensatory Education Funds
- Campus Coverage for JHS, VMHS, and WHS:
  - o One Coordinator including the At-Risk Counselor one night a week
  - One teacher per 20 students at JHS and WHS
  - Cost for Supplemental Pay 2019 School Year:

 Campus Coverage for JLA: Flexible Schedule took place during the school day - no additional costs

 The Goal of OFSDP is to reduce the number of high school dropouts
