

LEGAL NOTICE

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADOPTION OF PREVAILING WAGE

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted the Prevailing Wage Act and,

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the SPEED S.E.J.A. #802 of Cook County investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of said SPEED S.E.J.A. #802.

SECTION 1: To the extent and as required by the Prevailing Wage Act, the general prevailing wage in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the SPEED S.E.J.A. #802 is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Cook County area, as determined by the Department of labor of the State of Illinois as of June of the current year, a copy of that determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department's June determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by SPEED S.E.J.A. #802. The definition of any terms appearing in the Resolution which are also used in aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

SECTION 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the SPEED S.E.J.A. #802 to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

SECTION 3: The SPEED S.E.J.A. #802 Clerk or Secretary shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of SPEED S.E.J.A. #802 this determination of any revisions of such prevailing rate of wages. A copy of the determination of the currently revised determination of the prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.

SECTION 4: The SPEED S.E.J.A. #802 Clerk or Secretary shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer and to any association of the employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses and have requested copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

SECTION 5: The SPEED S.E.J.A. #802 Clerk or Secretary shall promptly file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Secretary of State of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 6: The SPEED S.E.J.A. #802 Clerk or Secretary shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a copy of this Resolution, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.
