Mr. Ismael Mijares, Deputy Superintendent for Business & Finance, addressed the Board and Superintendent and reviewed the budget and explained the four categories of funds/budgets as per TEA requirements, which are the General Fund (GF's are divided among 20 sub-funds), Special Revenues Funds, Debt Services Funds, and Capital Project Funds. The General Funds are State Mandated programs such as Food Services. Most of the money is in the General Fund (M&) 89%, Special Revenue fund at 8% and Debt Services Fund at 2%, Special Revenue Fund includes the Food Service Summer Program as required by law, it is a Federal Grant received, it is an entitlement, as the Visually Impaired Program received from the State under Special Education Program, the IMA (Instructional Materials Allotment), and the Elementary Fund these are the Special Revenue Funds, these are funds designated by the State and how it is to be used. Mr. Mijares reviewed the budget groups as required by TEA (General Fund, Debt Services Fund, special Revues fund, and Capital Projects Fund) All school districts in the state of Texas prepare their budgets in this manner. TEA requires all districts to post their budget on district website, excluding the Food Service Program as it audited every year. Our Funding Source of Revenue is 68% from State Funds, 17% Taxes, 13% Federal and 2% from Local Funding. The District is one of the few in the state that have Self-Funding Health Insurance, Workers Compensation and Unemployment. Other budgetary matters included budget assumptions, proposed budget workshop schedule, additional request and other budgetary issues. EPISD has a complete and balanced budget and is a very good budget. Board Members. Questions and concerns were addressed.
