June 8 to July 1, 2026, running Monday through Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. We will also host a special family session on Wednesday, July 1, from 10:00 to 11:30 a.m., during which students will share their summer learning with families through a celebratory program.

Our program will use a fun, theme-based approach to learning, where students will continue building their literacy and math skills in meaningful and interactive ways. In addition to academic practice, we will place a strong emphasis on collaboration, community-building, and experiential learning.

Each Thursday, students will participate in special hands-on learning experiences designed to bring our weekly themes to life.

Additionally, each Monday we will launch a weekly citizenship project focused on doing good for the larger community. These projects will encourage students to think beyond themselves, work together, and make a positive impact.

Due to construction at the school this summer, the program will be held at the Nicollet Legion. We are incredibly grateful for their generosity in providing us with a welcoming space for our students and staff.

Each day will follow a consistent and engaging schedule:

- Morning check-in and community-building project
- Literacy learning time
- Snack break
- Math learning time
- Whole-group time featuring camp-style games, collaboration, and team-building
