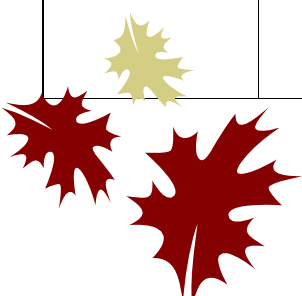

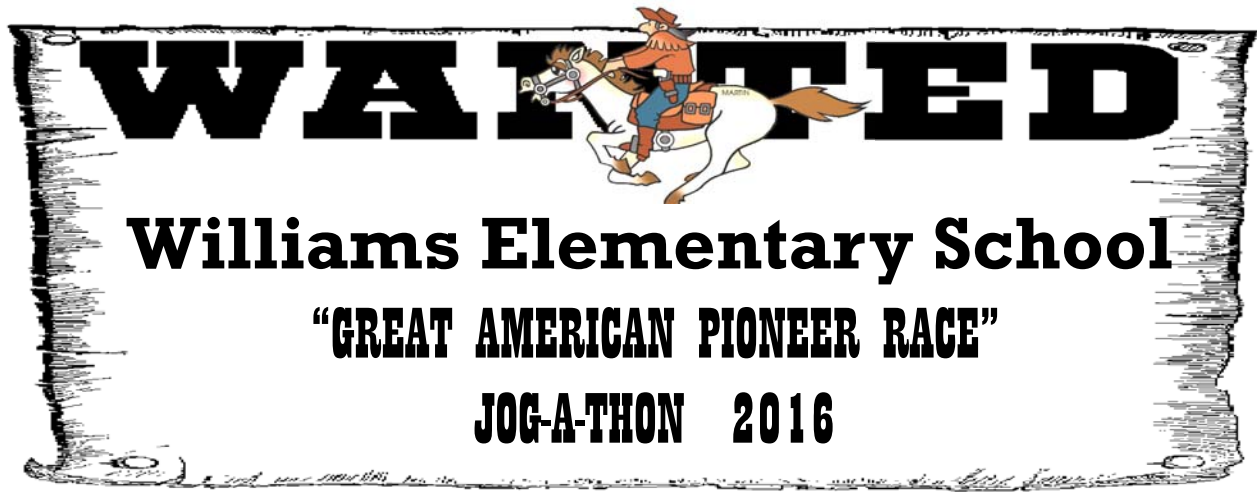

IMPORTANT SCHOOL INFORMATION

TRANSPORTATION CHANGES:

If you need to call to change your child's transportation plans for the day, the calls from parents only need to be made prior to 1:00 PM.

STUDENT MEDICATION:

If your child needs to take medication at school it is a State Law that all medicine to be taken at school is to be brought to school by an adult in the original container and kept in the office. A "Request for giving Medication Form" must be filled out by the parent along with the medication. Cough drops are included as a medication and must be in the original container.
