Curriculum/Instruction:

<u>Open Court Professional Development</u> - Today Jan. 15th , and half day tomorrow Jan. 16th PRE Teachers were able to have classroom demonstrations in each grade level by Samantha Hannah an Open Court Trainor, and a questions and answer time after each demonstration. We also had Sam share about the intervention component at our staff meeting this afternoon.

<u>Daily Academic Intervention</u> - Teams recently met, and rearranged intervention groups. It was great to see the student growth. Their academic improvement moves them to the next skill they need to work on. Many students were removed from intervention groups and put in enrichment groups.

<u>Grade Level Professional Learning Communities PLCs</u> - Our grade level PLCs are continuing to work on the four essential questions of the PLC. 1. What do we want our students to know?, 2. How well do we know if they learned it? 3. What will we do if they don't?, and 3 What will we do if they know it? They meet weekly for 45 minutes in their grade level PLCs.
