Subject: 2021-22 Instructional Allotment and TEKS Certification

Information

BOARD GOAL:

- Increase the percentage of scholars graduating college career and military ready
- Increase the percentage of 3rd grade (all students) scholars reading at/or above grade level
- Increase the percentage of Algebra I scholars scoring Meets or above

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

School districts and charter schools are required to certify annually to the State Board of Education and the commissioner that, for each subject in the required curriculum other than physical education, students have access to instructional materials that cover all the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS). Districts must submit certifications to receive access to ordering 2021–22 instructional materials using the instructional materials allotment (IMA) funds.

Prior to the 2021-2022 school year, the Allotment and Certification form required the implementation of TEKS only. Due to an intense focus on mitigating the learning loss caused by the pandemic, the 2021-2022 Allotment and Certification Form requires that districts submit the titles of the state adopted resources, the curriculum used, and the process for implementing the curriculum and instructional materials at the campus level.
