Re: Reading Intervention Program Grades 6-12

The district determined there was a need for a research-based solution to provide reading support so that K-8 students continue to show progress in reading. As a result, the district issued an RFP on February 28, 2022, to select a company to provide a resource for teachers to progress monitor reading achievement and can measure that growth for K-8 students. The district received two compliant responses.

An evaluation committee comprised of representatives from both campus and central administration departments evaluated those responses to establish the best value. The resulting tabulation of those evaluations provided the following supplier, in ranked order.

- 1. Houghton Mifflin Harcourt Publishing Company
- 2. Voyager Sopris Learning, Inc.

District administration will attempt to negotiate a successful contract with the first ranked vendor, and if unsuccessful, we will move to the next ranked vendor.

The district administration intends to use ESSER funds to cover the cost of this service for at least the first year of the award.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approves the administration to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the recommended suppliers, renewed annually, not to exceed approximately \$140,000.00 annually, as long as the service continues to meet the needs of the District.
