Hello EAOCS Team!

As you are aware, an election for one (1) six-year term on the Oakland Schools Board of Education will be held on **Monday, June 1, 2026**. Thank you to those who have already submitted their Board's election resolutions!

I've had a few questions throughout this process and I thought it may be helpful to share the answers with all.

- The District Designee or Alternate does not have to be a Board member. The Designee can be any district representative that the Board delegates.
- The District Designee must cast their ballots **in person** at the election scheduled to take place between 5:30 p.m.–7:30 p.m. on Monday, June 1, 2026, in the Oakland Schools Conference Center located at 2111 Pontiac Lake Road in Waterford. **The revised ISD election law prohibits the acceptance of absentee ballots.** Although it is not required, it is recommended that the District Designee or Alternate remain present at the Election through the *Announcement of the Election Results*.
- A copy of the Board's adopted resolution must be submitted to the Oakland Schools Superintendent's office by **4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 29, 2026**, via email to [Nicole.Christian@oakland.k12.mi.us](mailto:Nicole.Christian@oakland.k12.mi.us). **Please note that no resolutions shall be accepted after 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 29, 2026.** If the resolution is not submitted by the deadline, the constituent district will be unable to cast a vote during the election.
