Authority for this Action	EHDC (Legal and Local) Alternative Methods for Earning Credit: Credit by Examination Without Prior Instruction
Goal/Objective Addressed	District Goal 1: College or Career Readiness Graduates of Crosby ISD will be prepared for success after high school by being adequately prepared for either college or work force success.
Background	Credit by exam (CBE) is one method for students to demonstrate proficiency in grade level or course content. The Texas Education Code (TEC), §28.023, allows students to either accelerate a grade level or earn credit for a course based on credit by examination.  Credit by examination assessments (CBEs) must be approved by each local board of trustees for their district. CBEs are administered by the district or test provider in accordance with local district policy. Scores are reported directly to the school district and/or student. TEA does not have access to student results for CBE.  For each high school course, a local board is required to approve at least four CBEs, to the extent available. Exams that must be accepted as CBE assessments are those developed by —  • The College Board Advanced Placement (AP), and • The College-Level Examination Program (CLEP), Additional CBE assessments may be purchased from or developed by—  • Texas Tech University ISD,  • The University of Texas at Austin High School,

Staffing	A parent request has been submitted for a student to take the American Sign Language exam prior to the start of the 2025 – 26 school year.  Staff members will proctor the assessment for each test administration.
