

students will be resilient, lifelong learners



## Wood Dale District 7 Mission Statement

In the area of STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT, the Board will ensure the staff has the resources needed to provide high quality instruction and engaging learning experiences for each student.

- A. By June 2020, using Spring to Spring scores, the average student RIT score on the NWEA MAP reading and math assessments will increase 1.0 point more than the national average increase at grades 1-8. (LINK TO EACH GRADE LEVEL GOAL)
- B. Provide support and opportunities for faculty to develop Social Emotional Learning (SEL) assessments and apply the SEL standards to their instructional units.
- C. Provide support for implementation of year 2 of the 3 year Otus plan (LINK TO PLAN)
- D. Monitor the planning for successful implementation of full-day kindergarten and developmentally appropriate practices for early childhood-3rd Grade

In the area of FAMILY & COMMUNITY RELATIONS, the Board will provide the staff with the resources needed to increase District 7's level of engagement with all school families and the local community.

- A. Increase the engagement of all families with the school community by continuing to provide resources to research, develop, implement, and evaluate high quality family engagement strategies.
- B. Increase community awareness of positive activities taking place at Wood Dale through engagement with local businesses and senior citizen groups.

In the area of FINANCE & OPERATIONS, the Board will ensure the budget and financial plan is aligned with the district's vision, mission & goals, while respecting the financial resources of the community.

- A. Evaluate all contracts with vendors to investigate potential cost savings in current and future agreements.
- B. Develop a detailed plan for implementing the Five-Year Financial Plan.
- C. Review & select projects to complete from the operations & maintenance plan, to ensure an engaging and safe learning environment for all students and staff.
