Grant Application Narrative

I. Purpose of Grant

The Passages program has begun and is expanding its Transition program for the upcoming school year. We will be focusing on Social Skills, Life Skills, Work Skills, and Work-based Learning. One of the activities that we do, frequently, is meal plan, budget, shop and cook meals. We are in dire need of cooking supplies. We are currently using very old things, or borrowing from the kitchen. It would be wonderful to have our own equipment. Here is a list of the things we would like to purchase:
