Federal Budgeting and Planning for 2015-16

Summer School

We are in the planning stages of our summer school sessions with Marsing.

- Our first summer school session will be held during the month of June and will be only for K-6 Migrant students of Marsing and Homedale. It will be housed at Homedale Elementary and Christine Ketterling will be overseeing the administration of this program.
- The second session is a "Jump Start" session and will include invited K-5 at-risk students in Homedale and Marsing. This will be held for three weeks, beginning at the end of July. Marsing will host this program on their campus as they already have the structure and resources in place from running the program the past several years. Marsing's 21st Century program will be partnering with the Jump Start summer school to provide support in implementing the program.

This yearly conference focuses on the unique needs of migrant students.
