2002 Big Changes In Minidoka County Schools

<u>2002</u> East and West Minico <u>Middle</u> Schools Were created. <u>Emphasis</u>:

- Advisory
- Exploratory classes
- Teaming

Intended purposes of advisory:

- Assure students will have an **adult advocate** (Advisor).
- Guarantee that every student belongs to a peer group.
- Help every student find ways of being **successful** within the **academic and social** options the school provides.
- Promote **communication and coordination** between home and school.
- Agree that there will be **no grade** for Advisory.

Anecdotal studies have suggested that Advisories promote:

- Lower dropout rates.
- Improved attendance.
- Increases in self-confidence.
- Perceived safer school.
- Perceived increase in overall pleasant school atmosphere.

District Data Concerns

- Less academic class time.
- Larger mainstream classes.
- Lower grades and test scores.
- Little or no comparative data.*

*2002-03 ended of Direct Writing Assessment and Iowa Test of Basic Skills. Started ISAT 1. Continued with the Direct Math Assessment which our scores dropped continually for the next several years (per data from Jodi Mills) prior to discontinuation. "...There are very few rigorous studies (about advisories) from which to determine the effects on student outcomes...Schools developing advisories have relied upon intuition and anecdotal evidence rather than empirical data" (Shulkind & Foote, 2009). McClure, L., Yonezawa, S., & Jones, M. (2010) Positive perceptions of advisory programs were associated with worse academic outcomes
