
SHARS UPDATE

Below is a current timeline of the SHARS informal review submitted to the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) as a result of the FFY2022 Cost Report payment settlement adjustment.

- **November 30, 2023** Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) sent out notice to Medicaid services and billing providers notice about recoding and recalculation of the SHARS settlement payment.
- December 15, 2023 HHS released results of the FFY2022 Cost Report.
- January 9, 2024 Written request submitted to HHS Provider Finance, through the STAIRS Fairbanks portal, for 15-calendar day extension to submit an Informal Review Request in accordance with 1 TAC §355.110(c)(1)(A). In the same letter a request for extension on the informal review deadline to be moved 45 calendar days from the date of the written notice of adjustment, January 31, 2024 (TAC §355.8443).
- March 1, 2024 deadline (by law) for HHSC to submit a decision to the district on the informal review.

While there have been many districts that have already received a denial letter (many received it on March 5, 2024) from HHSC on their request for informal review, Brownsville ISD has yet to receive an approved or denied letter from HHSC.


