Eagle Point Program / BIST:

We have completed the ninth month of our Eagle Point Behavior Incentive Program. Students who met the goal of 95-100 points last month will participate in the Golden Eagle Point Party - Extra Recess (student-picked!) 80% of the student population earned the party this month. As decided on by the School Improvement Team, the point requirement increased from 90-95

points; making it more difficult for students to earn, and teaching the importance of responsibility and accountability.

Our social worker and interventionists have been working together with administrators to improve truancy. Kids who are high risk have been assigned to an interventionist for a daily check in. We have seen improvements in their attendance and they look forward to seeing that adult at school.
