RE: Lone Star Governance Student Outcome Goal Progress

Pursuant to the Lone Star Governance (LSG) framework, Canutillo ISD administration is required to update the Board of Trustees on progress toward meeting student outcome goals. In alignment with the district's LSG calendar, Goal 3 – the percentage of graduates earning a CCMR indicator – will be the focus for the month of February.

LSG Goal 3:

The percentage of graduates who earn a CCMR indicator will increase from 64% (2022) to 88% by June 2026.

Recent CCMR performance data indicate that the district has not yet reached projected milestones, prompting targeted support and strategic action. The Advanced Academics Coordinator is collaborating closely with Canutillo High School administrators and counselors on a weekly basis to strengthen CCMR outcomes. Current efforts include:

- TSI testing coordination and intervention strategies to increase participation and passing rates;
- Review and expansion of Advanced Placement (AP) offerings to enhance college readiness opportunities; and
- Monitoring and planning for Dual Credit/Dual Enrollment courses to align with current and future student pathways.

These actions are designed to ensure ongoing alignment with district targets and to maintain collective awareness among board members and district leadership regarding progress toward achieving LSG Goal 3.
