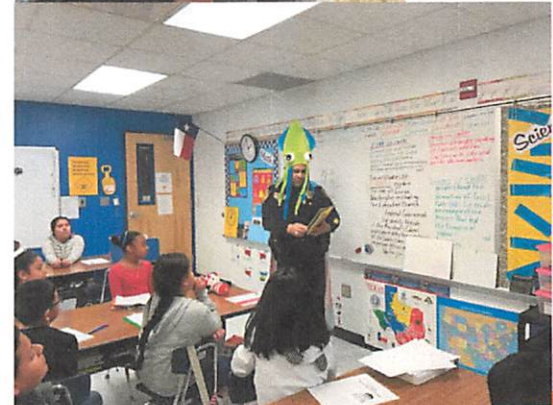

Mission Statement:

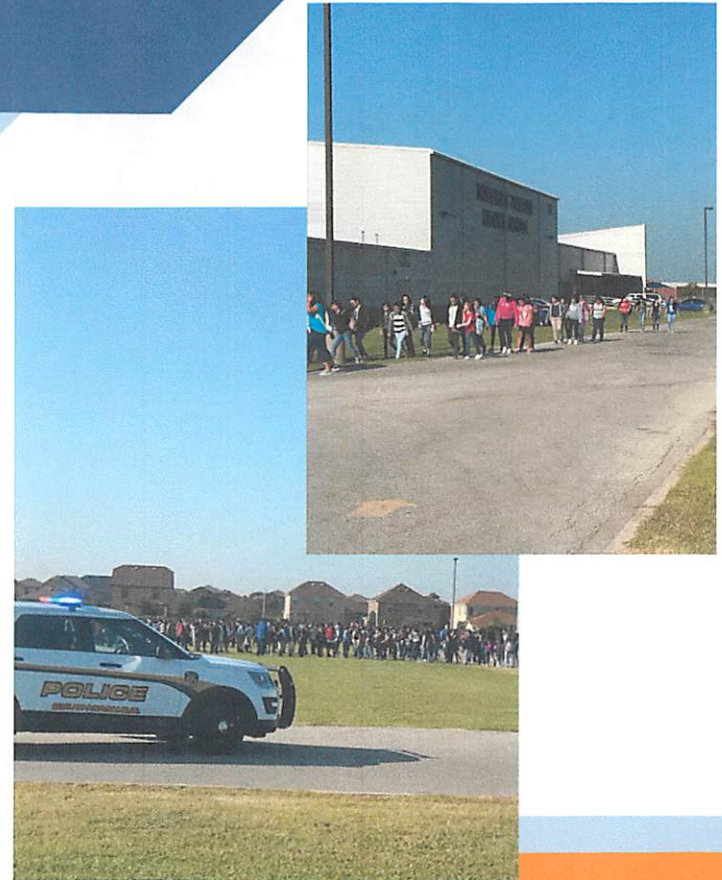
