## 203.2 ORDER OF THE REGULAR SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

  - 5. Approval of Agenda
  - 6. Scheduled Presentations
  - 7. Old Business
  - 8. New Business
  - 9. Approval of Consent Agenda
  - 10. Open Discussion items
  - 11. Administrative Reports:
- B. Board Reports
- C. Committee Reports
- D. Superintendent's Reports
- E. Principal's Reports
- F. Upcoming Meetings
- G. Adjournment.
- H. The school board may depart from the order of business with the consent of the majority of members present.
