RE: Textbook Report for the 2007-2008 Purchase Year

Attached Chart B provides summary data of the textbook purchases made in the 2007-2008 school year. Individual school purchases of textbooks have been divided into the categories of adopted textbooks, non-adopted textbooks, and shipping. Textbook funds spent in these three categories have been converted to percentages.

As previously reported, the TPSD attempts to implement a 3-year purchase cycle so that by the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> purchase year all students will have access to the most current textbook adopted in the given content area, grade and course. Chart A provides the adoption year and the third purchase year for textbooks adopted in the five (5) core content areas.

On the far right side of attached Summary Chart B, a "Yes" or "No" response is provided indicating whether or not each school had completed the purchase of the adopted textbook for each content area during the 2007-2008 school year. Please note that purchase of English/Literature textbooks is not scheduled to be completed until the 2009-2010 purchase year.

Attached Summary Chart C provides an individual school listing of the 2007-2008 textbook appropriation by fund. A breakdown of 2007-2008 individual school expenditures with the names of textbooks purchased is provided in Chart D.

As previously stated, Chart D provides an individual, detailed listing of 2007-2008 textbook purchases by school, purchase requisition number, and title of the textbook. The information provided on Chart D has been used to provide the summary data on Charts B and C, respectively.
