NSBSD Policy Manual:

Board Bylaw 9130, Board Committees: The School Board may establish committees of the Board as deemed necessary. The membership of these committees is limited to less than majority of the whole Board. The Board shall establish written charges for Board Committees. When its charges or duties have been completed, the committees shall be dissolved...The President may be a member of any committee.

Board Bylaw 9140, Board Representatives: The Board may appoint any of its members to serve on advisory committees or as its representative to other public agencies or organizations when the Board deems such appointments desirable, contingent on acceptance by the member.
