Teacher Resignations

Tenured teachers may resign at any time with consent of the School Board or by written notice sent to the Board Secretary at least 30 days before the intended date of resignation. However, no teacher may resign during the school term in order to accept another teaching position without the consent of the Board.

Teachers may resign at anytime with consent of the School Board. No teacher may resign during the school term in order to accept another teaching position without consent of the Board. A teacher may resign outside of a school term if the teacher provides written notice to the Superintendent or designee, at least 30 calendar days prior to the first student attendance day of the following school year. Teachers who resign with less than 30 days' notice prior to the first students attendance day of the following term will be deemed to have resigned during the school term.
