RE: 2024–25 Achievement and Integration (A&I) Progress Report

As required by the Minnesota Department of Education (MDE), Centennial Public Schools must submit an annual progress update on the district's Achievement and Integration (A&I) Plan.

For the 2024–25 school year, our plan includes **three goals** and **five strategies**. Progress reporting will be submitted to MDE this fall.

## **Achievement and Integration Goals**

**Goal 1** - Centennial's four year adjusted cohort graduation rate for students receiving free or reduced lunch the goal was 85% for Class of 2025 (Data not available for Class of 2025).

Did Not Meet - Graduation rate (2024) was 75.5% for four year adjusted cohort graduation rate. [Note: 7 Year Graduation Rate is 85.5%]
