Student Services: Second Step training for teachers at the elementary school and intermediate school in the summer as it will be taught at the intermediate schools in base groups this year. All student services have been trained as trainers in trauma informed care. They have trained staff in their buildings in caregiver capacity in the past year. They will be training their staff in the next six ingredients of care over the next two school years and will include ongoing follow-up activities. PSG will be providing therapy in all of our schools. Wellpoint will continue in selected schools that have enough students enrolled for services to support two days of therapy. Student services leads are gathering other options of agencies to consider for partnership.

Special Education: Summer training for teachers and EA's have an autism focus to better meet the needs of identified students. All schools are being evaluated to provide a sensory room for students that can benefit from the space. Locations and items to meet student needs are being determined. We are developing a process to better monitor and address special education teacher and support staff caseloads based on the average caseloads for districts in our region.
