Building Configuration Proposal

- The administrative team proposes to have K-6 in 3 or 4 schools and 7-12 in Red Wing High School for 2021-22 school year.
- This is the only option that allows us to be prepared to teach in all scenarios: in-person (all in), hybrid, distance learning.



December 15, 2020

- Staff meetings were held at every building to propose a K-6, 7-12 configuration.
- Survey was to gather data and gain insights from our colleagues on our proposed configuration for next year.



7-12 Survey Breakdown

- Themes our administration gleaned from the survey:
 - Technology needs across the high school
 - Materials and Supplies still needed from previous classrooms
 - Teaching assignments for 21-22
 - Class size questions
 - Scheduling questions
 - Elective class concerns
 - Food service questions and efficiency



Technology Questions

- Google Education Suite
 - Google Classroom (YES)
- Go Guardian (we would want to continue if budget allows)
- Edgenuity
 - For credit recovery (YES)
- For a full time online learning option (YES)
- Other software and online programs through technology department (Case by case basis)





Materials and Supplies still needed from previous classrooms

- Yes, we will be moving all materials and supplies as necessary from your previous location.
- All building infrastructure stays at the current site:
 - Example: SMARTBoard, desk, etc.



Teaching Assignments for 21-22

- All teaching assignments, per master agreement, will be mailed out by Human Resources by August 1, 2021.
- All 7-12 teaching assignments will be communicated by Mr. Nemanich as soon as known. (Target: May-June)
- These decisions will be based off registration, budget, enrollment.



Class Size 7-12

- Our goal is to keep class size as low as possible.
- Again, class size will be dependent on registration, budget, and enrollment.



Scheduling questions

- 7-8 will be scheduled to meet the needs of this age group.
- 9-12 may be scheduled different than 7-8 to meet the needs, registration, and credit requirements of a high school student.
- Schedule Options
 - Several options are on the table.



Elective Class concerns

- We want to continue to keep a robust elective curriculum.
- These class offerings are pending other decisions:

- Budget
- Enrollment
- Registration
- Schedule
- Staffing
- Etc.



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Food service questions and efficiency

- Lunch time for 7-12 students.
 - With the addition of 7th grade, this may look different than previous years.
 - We will need to add some equipment in the kitchen and tables in the cafeteria.
 - 3-4 lunch periods per day
- We will continue to operate on the same breakfast procedures.
