We, the North Valley High School family and Three Rivers School District recently lost a longtime, cherished, well respected, and impactful teacher and coach to thousands that attended North Valley High School. Jeff Richard was the cornerstone of many successes on the athletic fields and in the weight room or classroom over his 30 years at NVHS. Jeff's Impact on students' lives cannot be summed up in a brief letter, nor should it be attempted. His dedication to our school's students and athletes is unmatched in the school's history, as evident in the fact that he never missed one day of teaching in the first 28 years of his career, and only missed time in the last few years, because he earned the right to use up his personal days or lose them. His straightforward approach to coaching and teaching is something not found today, with a no excuses attitude and "just find a way to get it done" mantra, that many will lay testament as to why so many look back now and respect how he was helping to lay the foundation for his students to succeed in whatever path they chose. An icon who many of us have had the pleasure of playing for, been a student, coached with him, or played a round of golf with him respect and appreciate his competitive fire and desire to be the best at whatever you set out to achieve.

- Jeff taught at NVHS for 30 years
- Jeff coached Football, Track, Wrestling, Baseball, and ran a successful weight program and physical education curriculum.
- Jeff was a Head Coach and Assistant for most of his years at NVHS
- Jeff came to NVHS shortly after it opened and helped steer the early years as the school was gaining traction
- Jeff had a direct impact on the athletic success that thousands of athletes have achieved
- Jeff more importantly, impacted thousands of students who didn't play sports, but pushed them to be athletes
 in their own endeavors, or just at least get out and move to get exercise.
- Jeff was a Coach of the Year
- Jeff was a coach on the staff of the football team the year NVHS won the Triple Crown and had impact on that group of athletes in all three sports that year.
- Jeff coached State Champion Track athletes
- Jeff never complained, well maybe a whine here and there, but just put his head down and went to work to make kids better.

This list is a small sample of his accomplishments, but the biggest one of all is how many kids he positively impacted at North Valley for the 30 years he was in the building. His devotion to his kids at North Valley is only second to his devotion to his Wife Belinda, Son Brian, Daughter Kathi, and later his grandkids.

We as a Family at North Valley respectfully are asking the school District to consider naming the football field at The North Valley stadium, "Jeff Richard Field".. And make what is long-due, a gesture of thanks for his years of dedication to the North Valley Kingdom of students, athletes, and families.
