UCSA Portfolio of Services: Programs

Descriptions:

- Bullying Awareness & What to Do: A community centered program for primary and secondary education groups. Students and Educators come together to learn the who, what, where, when, and why of bullying. Students learn how to become allies and Educators learn how to become advocates, creating a safer campus for all.
- Conflict Resolution: A community centered program for all groups that provides knowledge and skills related to resolving conflicts by focusing on active listening and respectful communication.
- Dialogue: A community centered program for all groups that provides a safe environment where participants learn how to effectively communicate by getting to know one another on a more personal level while building trust within the group, allowing for openness and honesty.
- How to Get Along with Others: A community centered program for all groups that provides an opportunity to focus on increasing awareness through empathy and sensitivity in human relations. The work is to shift away from "I" and "Me" and towards "Us" and "We" through accountability, responsibility, and community.
- Understanding & Appreciating Our Differences: A community centered program for all groups that provides an opportunity to focus on our differences, traits, and characteristics; and how they affect our individual choices and decisions, and relations within both internal and external communities. The goal is to build awareness and appreciation by going beyond simple tolerating to result in genuine respect and heartfelt acceptance.

UCSA Staff providing services will work to comply with all policies, procedures, and requests of South San ISD; all in good faith efforts as to not place the mutually agreed upon start date or term of service in jeopardy.
