• <u>Student Recognition</u>

- 2024-2025 Commendable School Summative Designation/UTHS School Report Card: Beginning in 2018, each Illinois school began receiving a Summative Designation, a measure of progress in academic performance, school climate, and student success. United Township High School has earned the designation of Commendable School, a school that has no underperforming student groups, a graduation rate greater than 67%, and whose performance is not in the top 10% of schools statewide, beginning in 2017-2018 through the 2024-2025 school year.
