

2013-14 Compliance with Division 22 Standards

POLICY ISSUE/SITUATION

On or before April 15, the Superintendent must complete and present an annual report to the community that the School District is in compliance with and is implementing as required, all of the Standards for Public Elementary and Secondary Schools as set out in OAR Chapter 581, Division 22, including all new and revised rules.

To verify compliance with the Division 22 Standards, the school district submits an Assurance Form to the Superintendent of Public Instruction signed by the District Superintendent. For any rules for which the District is not in compliance, a plan of correction must be submitted.

STATUS:

Staff have conducted an internal audit of the District's compliance with Division 22 requirements and have determined that the District is not in compliance with 6 of the 51 Division 22 Standards, included seven new or revised rules. The Assurance Form is attached for the Board to review.
