Denton Independent School District Districtwide JACE & Irrigation Controllers Upgrade Purchase

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quote from TD Industries in the amount of \$444,534.00 for the districtwide JACE (building systems controller) & irrigation controllers upgrade purchase.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management – Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

The Board called for the 2018 bond election with the recommendation by the Bond Committee. On May 5, 2018, the bond was approved by the voters of Denton ISD.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The upgrade of JACE and irrigation controllers will be funded using contingency from MEP projects that were included in the 2018 Bond Authorization. The total cost of upgrading the JACE and irrigation controllers districtwide is \$444,534.00.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

The upgrade of the JACE and irrigation controllers will be purchased from TD Industries through a Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative OMNIA contract. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne by the 2018 Bond Authorization budget.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will allow the District to order and have the JACE and irrigation controllers installed in the upcoming months.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the quote from TD Industries in the amount of \$444,534.00 for the districtwide JACE & irrigation controllers upgrade purchase be approved.
