<p><u>Objective #1.2 Improve progress in learning English</u></p>	<p>Ongoing Cree instruction with quarterly assessments will provide our Cree teachers with the necessary data needed to provide the adequate instruction. Through presentations, technology, hands on experiences, elder consultations, one on one interactions our Cree teacher will implement the Native Cree Language. Reading, writing, speaking, and listening activities also will increase English language proficiency.</p> <p>Through interventions and tutoring teachers will prepare students for WIDA Testing scheduled for January 2019.</p> <p>WIDA tested Kindergarten ELL December 16-20, 2019</p>

<u>Objective 2.2 Progress in Cree Language</u>	k-12 Cree Language instructors will provide test scores and percentile for students who are making progress in the Cree.
