# 1:1 Laptops

- Laptops have been collected, re-imaged, re-labeled for the new school year. Most computers ready for distribution on first day.
- Money for damage repairs is continuing to come in, slowly. Laptops will be repaired as payment is made. Repairs include replacement screens and keyboards, also replacement plastic parts.
- The IT Department with summer help was able to collect and prepare over 650 laptops for the start of the school year. Laptops not yet prepared are physical damage laptops waiting for repair payment. The remaining computers will be prepared as repair payments come in and warranty repairs are completed.
- Computers up-to-date and set up to be more efficient and easier for student use.
- Lenovo has agreed to extend the warranty of the devices to repair up to 200 laptops that had hinge problems, hard drive problems, and defective monitors. Repairs have been going smoothly & quickly.
