TITLE: Consider Ratification of Approval for an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Fiber Optic Network and Physical Path Sharing between the Collin County Community College District and the City of Plano

DISCUSSION: The City of Plano has a need to connect its Emergency Operations Center to its main technology center. The most advantageous route includes the use of about 7.25 miles of Collin College's 58-mile fiber network.

As part of this agreement, the College will have access to the City's fiber network as we expand eastward to Wylie.

This Interlocal agreement provides for cost-effective expansion of the City's and the College's fiber optic networks and will save the taxpayers of Collin County from redundant telecommunications expenses by these entities.

DISTRICT PRESIDENT'S RECOMMENDATION: The District President recommends ratification to approve an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Fiber Optic Network and Physical Path Sharing between the Collin County Community College District and the City of Plano.
