**Note: We do not believe this percentage reflects the true F/R rate for our district. In 2014-15 our Elementary Schools 1st became eligible for Community Eligibility Provision (CEP). Then starting 2018-19 two of our Elementary sites (Sacramento & Russell) were removed from eligibility due to low numbers therefore causing our Free and Reduced numbers to decline for 2019-20. As a result of this change (schools not on CEP) our 3 schools have shown a significant increase in unpaid fees for our nutrition program. At the





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end of 2018-19 our negative student balances was \$14,151. In 2019-20 we have increased the negative balance to \$21,520 with only 5 months into the academic year.
