

The Administration recommends that the Board of Trustees approve this Resolution approving the 2010 Preliminary Certified Appraisal Tax Roll for the Coppell Independent School District from the Dallas Central Appraisal District.

WHEREAS, the Chief Appraiser for the Dallas Central Appraisal District has, pursuant to Section 26.01(e), Texas Property Tax Code, as amended, certified to the Assessor/Collector of the Coppell Independent School District that part of the preliminary appraisal roll for the district that lists the property taxable by the district and the values thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Assessor/Collector for the District has, pursuant to Section 26.01(e), Texas Property Tax Code, as amended, determined the total preliminary appraised value, the preliminary total assessed value and the preliminary total taxable value of property taxable by the District, including that of new property; and

WHEREAS, the Assessor/Collector has, pursuant to Section 26.04(b) submitted the preliminary appraisal roll for the district to the Board of Trustees showing the total preliminary appraised, preliminary assessed, and preliminary taxable values of all property and the preliminary total taxable value of new property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE COPPELL INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>: The above and foregoing recitals are, and are hereby, found to be true and correct, and are incorporated into the body of

this Resolution verbatim.

<u>Section 2</u>: The preliminary appraisal roll as submitted by the District's Assessor/Collector for the tax year 2010 be, and is hereby, approved as the Property Tax Roll for the District.

Section 3: It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was considered was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of the said meeting was given and posted, all as required by Chapter 551, TEX GOV'T CODE, as amended.
