Consider that the normal range for an animal cell varies from 10 to 30 micrometers while that for a plant cell stretches from 10 to 100 micrometers and that all the organelles that are found in a cell are different, and the different jobs they do. Now think about how each organelle looks very different, just as your organs look different because they do different jobs. This is what the 7th grade graders have been doing in science. Their mission was to create a 3-D model of a plant or animal cell. They had instructions to include and label specific organelles. Then a key needed to be created to accompany their cell to explain the function or job of that organelle.
