Special Education:

Staff have been working very hard to develop schedules and services that address student learning goals from IEPs (Individual Education Plans). We are looking forward to the next several weeks as we begin our work on developing Student Learning Objectives that drive Professional Goals this year. We will be working as a PLC team to support this process.

SPED Caseload: 130 Students K-12

ELL:

Unfortunately the Mid-Valley Consortium for ELL was unable to acquire a lead district to support us, so it was dissolved by ODE this last month. Sheridan is no longer part of a consortium and is too small to claim ELL grant funding for professional development use for this year.

TAG:

Review of the Talented and Gifted program resulted in confirming three students identified as TAG in the district. This is a small percentage of our district population and work will be done this year to improve our identification process.
