Agenda Item: Consider Approval of the Resolution for Exception to Armed Peace Officer Requirement

Summary:

Section 37.0814 of the Texas Education Code, requires that school districts have commissioned police officers or a commissioned peace officer employed as security personnel on every campus during regular school hours. If the District is unable to hire or contract with commissioned peace officers, the Board of Trustees may declare an exception to the requirement for that reason and develop alternative standards with which it will comply. The administration is presenting a resolution declaring an exception. The District will hire armed security guards (TBD as appropriate) instead of commissioned police officers to immediately staff campuses with armed personnel as required by state law.
