2015-2016 Campus Improvement Plans

According to the Planning and Decision Making Process section of the Texas Education Code § 11.251, “the Board of Trustees of each independent school district shall ensure that a district improvement plan and improvement plans for each campus are developed, reviewed, and revised annually for the purpose of improving the performance of all learners. The board shall annually approve district and campus performance objectives.” Accordingly, the 2015-2016 Campus Improvement Plans are submitted for your approval.

The 2015-2016 Campus Improvement Plans were created using a comprehensive needs assessment for each campus and the 2015-2016 District Improvement Plan approved by the Board on April 27, 2015. In addition, considerations for plans were also based upon the action plans derived from the Pinnacle 2020 Strategic Planning Committee, Visioning Document, and the CISD Learning Framework.

All state and federal mandates required to be documented in the District Improvement Plan and Campus Improvement Plans have been documented in Appendix A. All core content area initiatives have been documented in Appendix B. Campuses will attach Appendix A and B to their Campus Improvement Plan, thus ensuring compliance and consistency in their work. Title I campuses will also attach Appendix C, which addresses the Ten Components of a Title I Program.
