

## Curriculum and Instruction

### Professional Development

Each building has completed their own PD's relevant to the building needs. BMS and BHS still receive training in MATH/READ 180 and Systems 44. Next year we will look at providing our own PD for this with our instructional coach. We are also considering using the ALEKS program. This program is an intervention program that compliments the new math program REVEAL that the high school and middle schools will be adopting. It is a computer adapted program that meets students where they are at. Currently we are working on PD needs for the summer and fall.

### District Committees

Our Social studies committee has met and the high school and middle school have opted to stay with the same program. The elementary grades are still deciding. I am hoping to bring this forward at the next board meeting. Racquel Little Plume is the Science Committee chair. They are currently looking at a few programs.

SBE is solidifying their schedule for June. Due to the lack of in person learning and the data available they will be focusing on scope and sequence to help move students along. Previous grade level units and modules will be revisited.

### Assessments

Due to the Department of Education not granting any waivers we have been prepping at each building for SBAC testing. We are also completing or have completed our benchmark testing.
