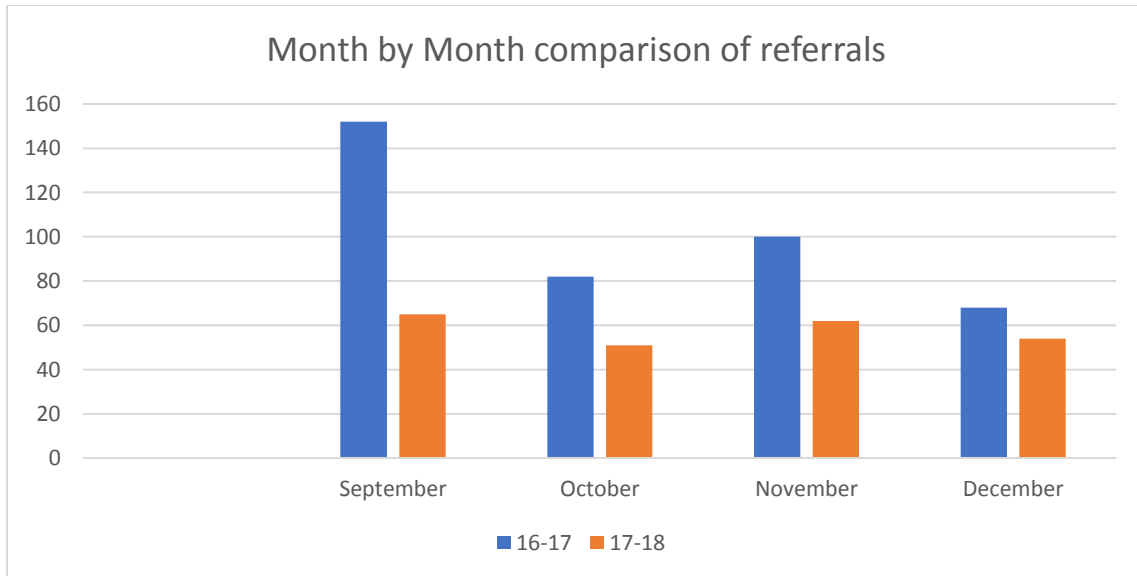


ISIP-Literacy Assessment
