BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

High school leadership teams are researching ways to improve student performance, student attendance, student apathy, and school climate. A 10-member School Reform Leadership Team has been created to lead the campus through implementation of reform strategies during the 2005-06 school year. Team members will participate in several conferences and training sessions through June, meet in July to identify reform strategies that will lead to improvement in area of focus, and lead the campus through the implementation during the next school year. The 2005 Model Schools Conferences is one of the conferences the team wishes to attend.

At the conference the nation's most successful schools from each state at (1) meeting or exceeding AYP requirements and (2) delivering an academically rigorous and relevant curriculum to ALL students will be showcased.
